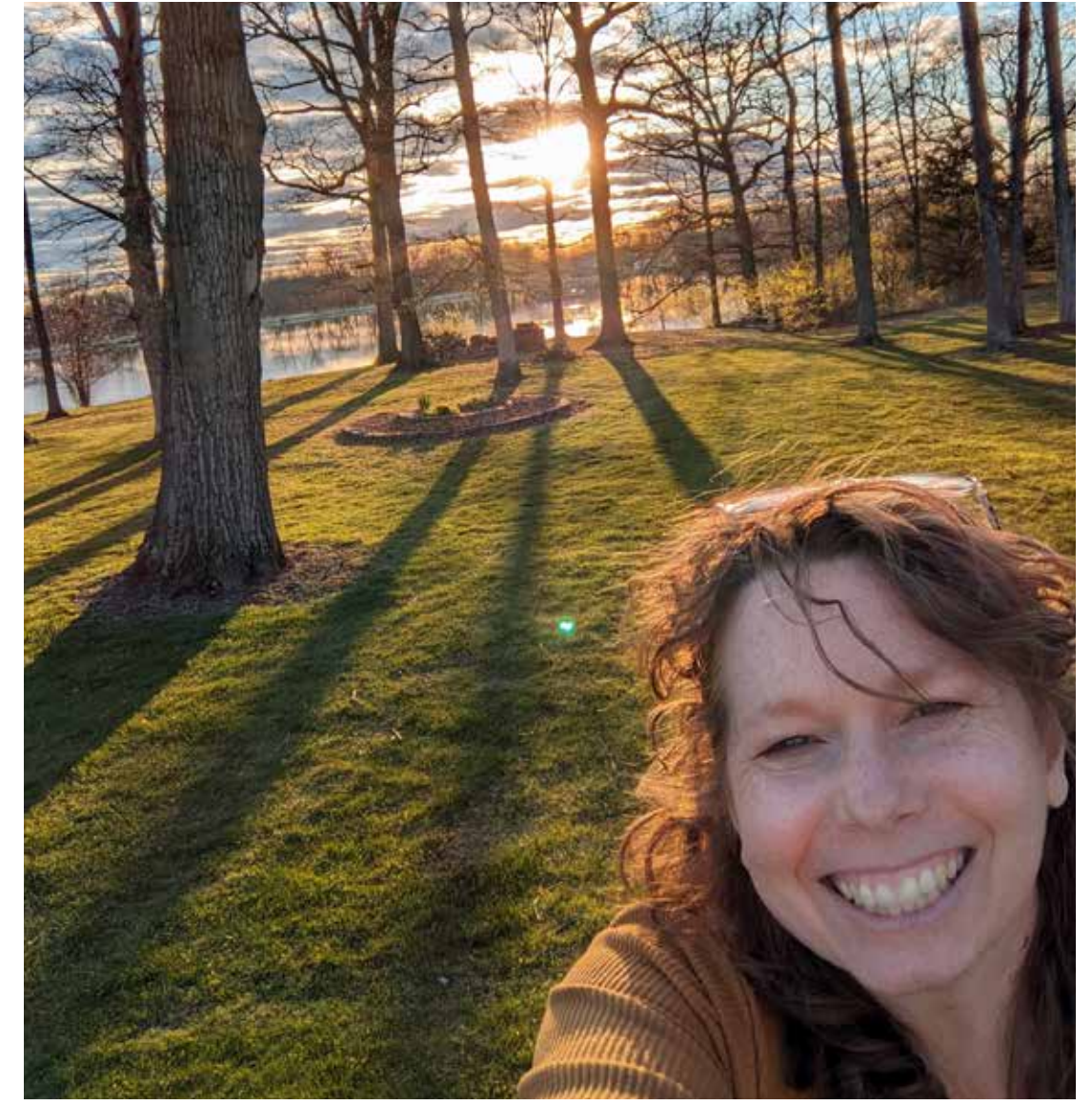
Dear Fellow RVers,

Sculpture Falls via Barton Creek Greenbelt

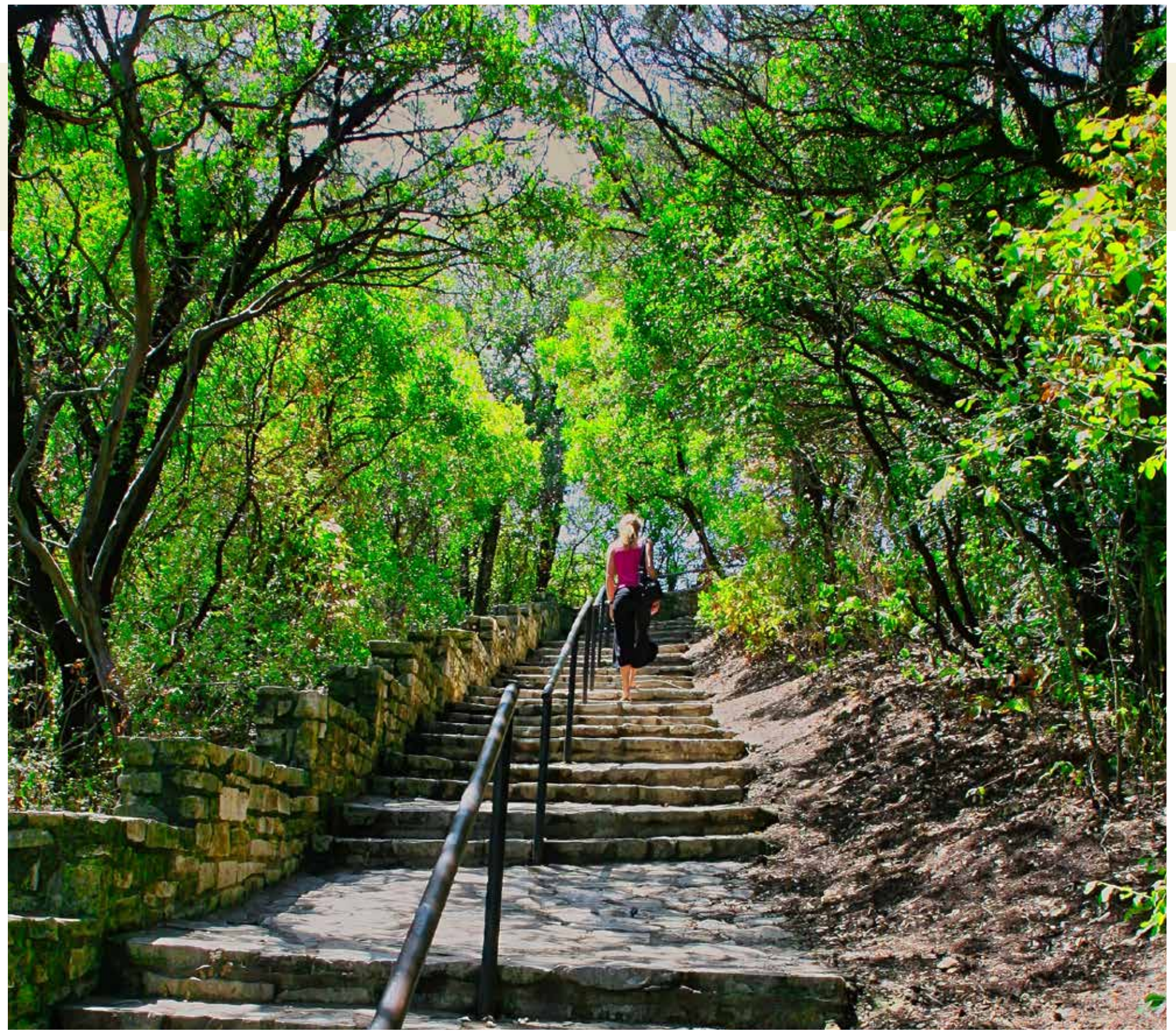

Beyond birdwatching, South Padre Island's beaches are made for splashing around, jet skiing, or simply soaking up the sun.

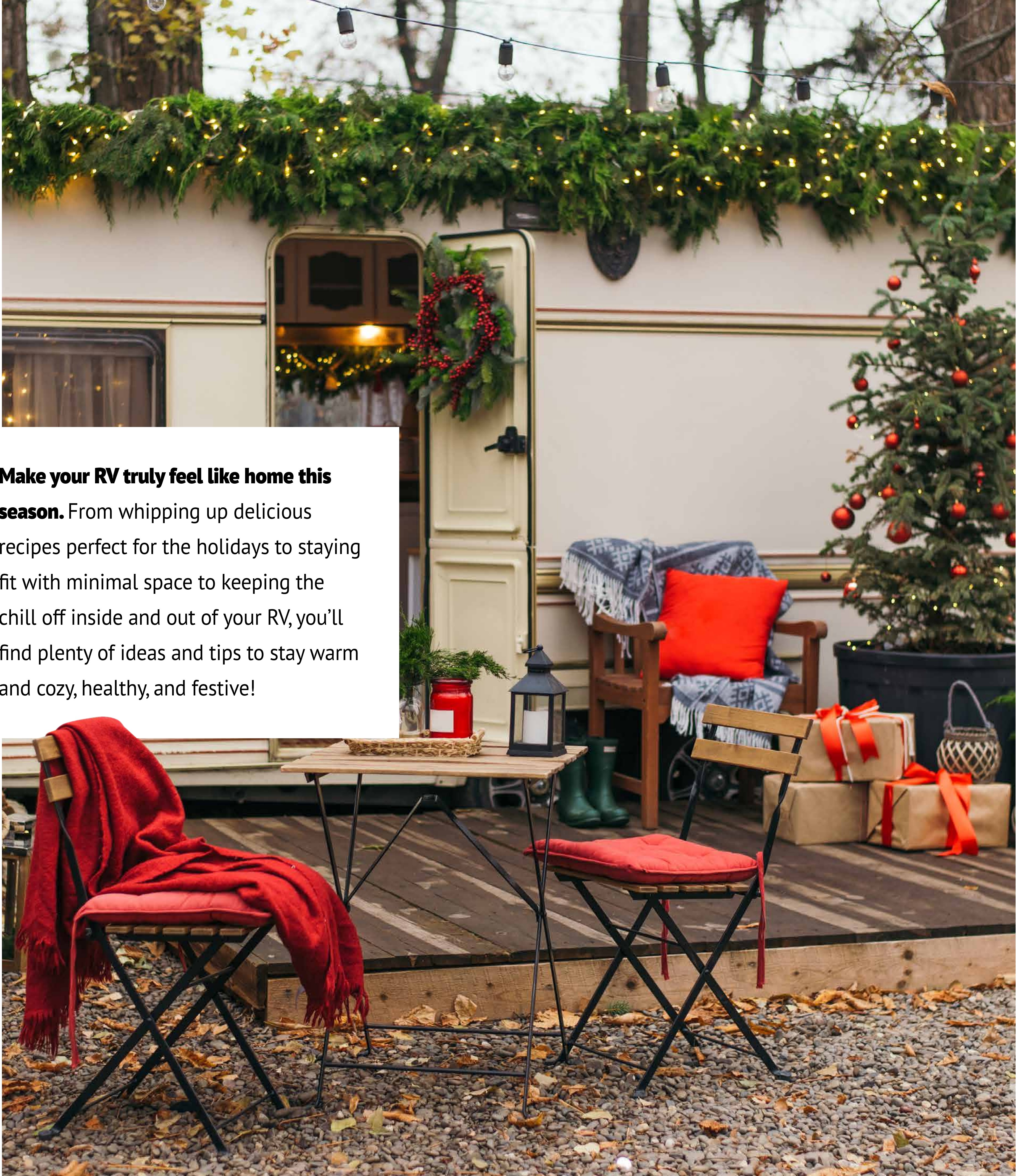

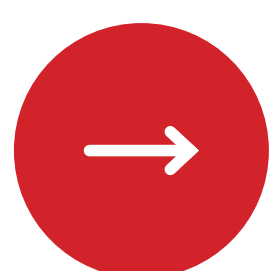


Festive & Flavorful

Or seek warmer weather and expansive views for a quiet holiday in nature. Or head up to the high country and stay cozy and warm surrounded by a snowy winter wonderland. No matter what your idea of a perfect holiday is, RVing provides a unique way to celebrate.

With a few simple decorations—think battery-powered string lights, mini ornaments, or a tabletop tree or holiday wreath—your RV can sparkle with the spirit of the season. And if the festive flavors are what bring the holidays to life for you, these simple recipes provide comfort and warmth and are perfect for sharing.

Holiday Stuffing Muffins



These individual stuffing muffins are so easy to make, even with limited space, and provide the comfort of a home-cooked holiday.

INGREDIENTS:

4 cups cubed bread (day-old works best)

1 cup cooked sausage (optional)

1/2 cup dried cranberries

1 stalk celery, chopped

1 small onion, chopped

1 tsp fresh rosemary, chopped (or 1/2 tsp dried)

1 tsp fresh sage, chopped (or 1/2 tsp dried)

Salt and pepper to taste

1 egg, beaten

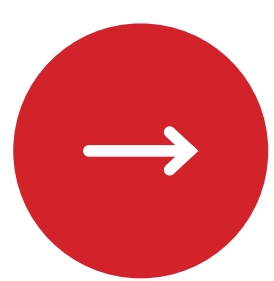
1 cup chicken or vegetable broth

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat your RV oven to 350° F.
2. In a large bowl, combine the bread, sausage, cranberries, celery, onion, herbs, salt, and pepper.
3. Add the beaten egg and broth, stirring until the bread is moistened.
4. Grease a muffin tin. Then, spoon the stuffing mixture into each cup until about half full.
5. Bake for 20 - 25 minutes or until golden brown.
6. Serve warm and enjoy!



Slow Cooker Mulled Cider



The comforting aroma of spiced cider will make your entire RV smell like the holidays. Plus, it's the perfect drink to warm up on chilly days with plenty to share the holiday spirit with others.

INGREDIENTS:

1 gallon apple cider

3 cinnamon sticks

1 tsp whole cloves

1 orange, sliced

1 Tbsp honey or maple syrup (optional for added sweetness)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Pour the apple cider into a slow cooker.
2. Add cinnamon sticks, cloves, and orange slices.
3. Set to low heat and let simmer for three to four hours, filling your RV with its festive aroma.
4. Serve in mugs, garnished with a cinnamon stick or orange slice if desired. Add some fun, festive music or your favorite holiday movie to delight all of your senses as you sip this traditional beverage.

GETTING FIT WITH THE BAND



IF YOU'VE HEARD IT ONCE, YOU'VE

HEARD IT A MILLION TIMES:

staying active is essential for health, no matter where the road takes you. Regular physical activity helps maintain strength

and stamina and increases energy. It can also help you live longer and add more life to your years. But if you're spending extensive time in an RV, staying fit can be a challenge.

Sure, you can join a national chain of gyms to make use of their facilities (where available). But depending on where you're staying, you may not have easy (or any) access when it's time to exercise. That's where resistance bands fit in. Literally.

BIG BENEFITS IN A SMALL PACKAGE

Resistance bands are lightweight, compact, and highly versatile, which makes them a perfect tool for travel-friendly fitness. Plus, they can be used to target every muscle group, providing a full-body workout.

Some research even suggests resistance bands can be as effective as other equipment for building strength. For instance, a study in the *Journal of Strength and Conditioning Research* found resistance bands provided similar strength gains to traditional weightlifting to improve muscle performance, endurance, and mobility. An ideal fit for RVers who want to stay healthy and relieve the stiffness and discomfort that so often come with long hours behind the wheel.

Whether you're on the road for a fun family vacay or life on the road is your full-time lifestyle, this quick, simple workout can be done anywhere, anytime.

20-MINUTE BAND WORKOUT

Caveat: Before you start, make sure your bands are in good shape and don't show any signs of fraying or tears, which can cause the band to break and could snap back and hurt you. If you are attaching the bands to anything, such as a door or another part of your RV, make sure it is firmly in place and the object is sturdy, again to prevent injury.

Okay. Ready? Start with a short (3- to 10-minute) warmup, such as a walk around the campground, some dynamic stretching, arms swings, shoulder rolls, and or marching in place. Then, shoot for 10 to 12 repetitions of each of the exercises below.

SQUATS

Targeting your legs and butt



Place the band just above your knees, and stand with your feet about hip-width apart. Squat as if you're sitting in a chair, keeping the band tight by pressing your legs into the band on the outside of your thighs. Return to standing and push the hips forward. Repeat.

SEATED ROWS

Targeting the back, shoulders, and arms

Sit down on the floor with your legs straight in front of you. Anchor the band around your feet or attach it to a sturdy, unmovable object. Holding onto each side of the band, relax your shoulders down, and pull the band toward you as if rowing while keeping your elbows close to your sides.

GLUTE BRIDGES

Targeting the glutes and hamstrings

Place the band around your thighs and lie on your back with your knees bent and your feet flat on the floor. Push through your heels as you lift your hips up into a bridge position, squeezing your glutes at the top. Slowly lower down and repeat.



STANDING SHOULDER PRESS

Targeting the shoulders and arms

Stand on the band, holding a handle in each hand. Then press the band overhead, lower it slowly, and repeat.

DEADLIFTS

Targeting the lower back, glutes, and hamstrings

Stand on the band with a handle in each hand. Bend the hips, keeping your back flat with only a slight bend in the knees. Then, return to standing and repeat.

KNEELING BICEPS CURLS

Targeting the biceps (front of the arms)



Kneeling on the band, with a handle in each hand and your palms facing forward, curling the handles toward your shoulders, squeezing your biceps at the top of the motion.

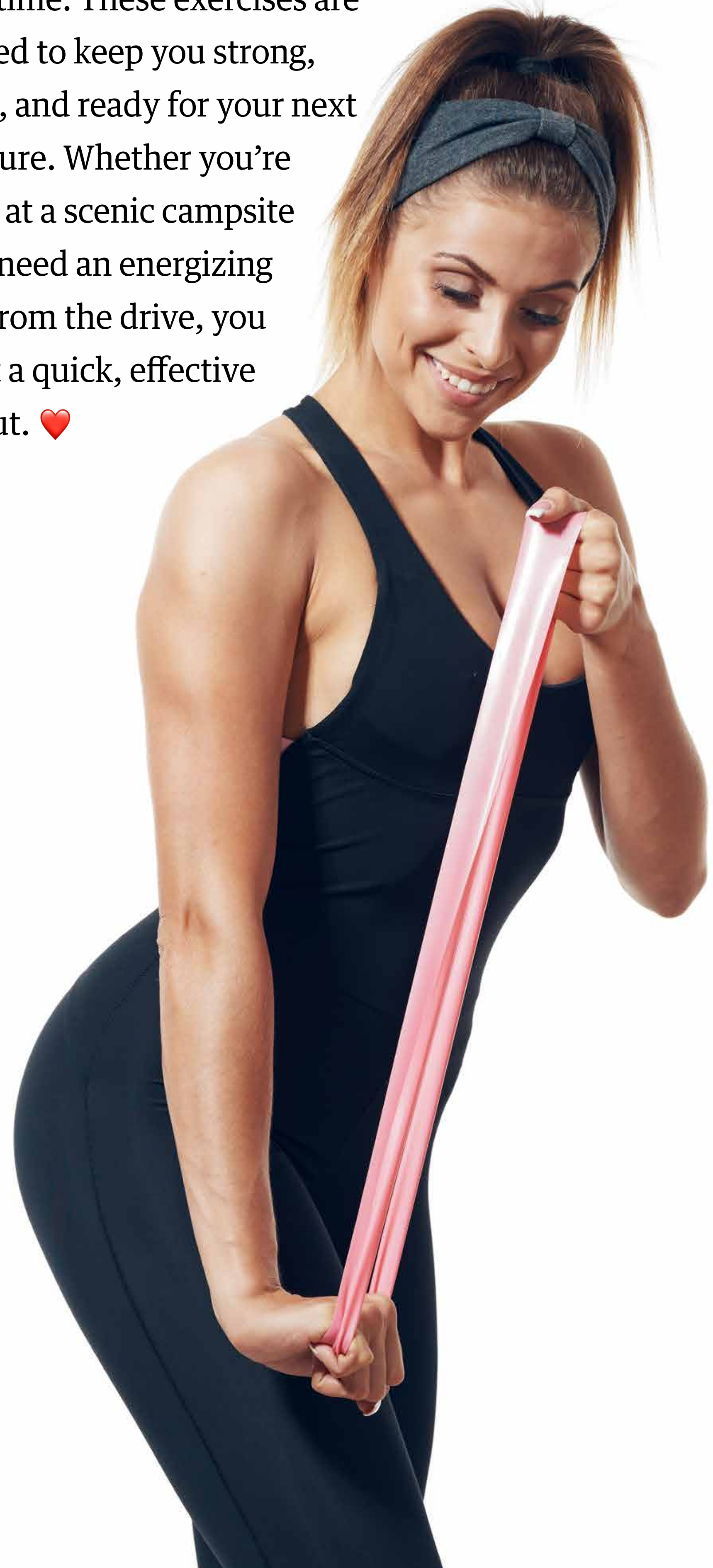
TRICEPS EXTENSIONS

Targeting the triceps (back of the arms)

Anchor the band overhead (such as in a tightly closed and locked door). Hold the handles with your elbows bent at a 90-degree angle. Extend your arms downward until fully straightened, squeezing your triceps at the bottom.

Aim for two to three rounds to work the entire body in 20 minutes. Then, spend another 3 to 5 minutes to cool down with some gentle stretches to release any remaining tension.

No matter where your RV adventures take you, it's easy to maintain a fitness routine with a simple set of bands of varying resistance and a little time. These exercises are designed to keep you strong, mobile, and ready for your next adventure. Whether you're parked at a scenic campsite or just need an energizing break from the drive, you can get a quick, effective workout. ❤️

IS

If you're like many Americans, fall is your favorite season. In fact, 41% of U.S. adults say fall is the best (compared to 11% who picked winter and 24% who chose spring or summer). And many RVers are falling in love with hitting the road during this spectacular season. Not only are the leaves putting on fabulous shows across the country, but as the air turns crisp, the campgrounds tend to calm.

That said, it can be a bit of a challenge to chase off the chill and extend the time you can enjoy being outdoors—especially as the sun drops earlier. Fortunately, a few simple tricks can help you extend your outdoor hours. All while staying cozy and warm and enjoying everything you love about RVing.

SO, WHAT ARE THE BEST WAYS TO KEEP THE COLD AT BAY?

Dressing in layers isn't just about being fashionable. It's one of the best ways to stay comfortable and cozy when the weather gets cooler. Layering allows you to easily regulate your body temperature by adding or removing clothing. That allows you to keep the body heat in and the cold air out, without overheating during the day or when you're more active.

In general, you'll want to start with a moisture-wicking base

layer that's snug and able to wick away moisture. That way, even if you sweat, your skin will remain dry, which is essential for staying warm. While synthetic materials, such as polyester, can be effective and are often advertised for these properties, natural fibers like merino wool are often preferred. That's because wool is naturally moisture-wicking, breathable, and insulating—even when wet. In addition, unlike synthetic fibers, wool resists odors, which is important when your wardrobe is limited and you wear the same layers repeatedly.

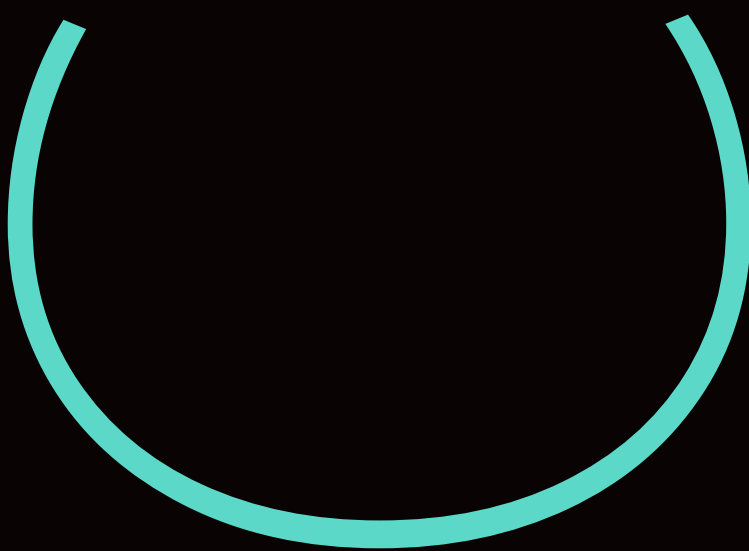
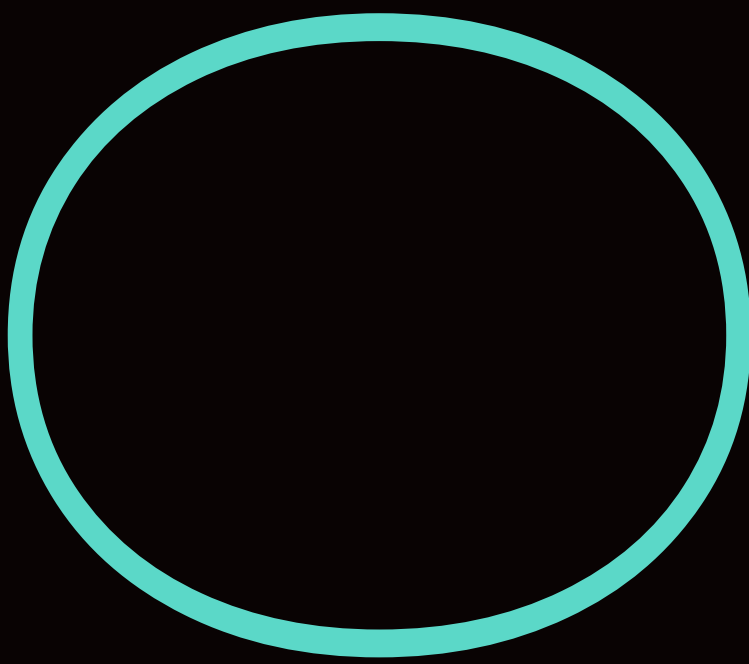
Next up is an insulating middle layer to keep you warm and cozy. Choose a fleece jacket, down vest, or wool sweater to keep the heat close to your body as the weather gets cool. Again, natural fibers tend to have an edge. Wool not only insulates well but it also holds up over time. Plus, it's a sustainable choice. And it's a great option for RVers looking for durability and longevity in their clothing.

Finally, add a lightweight, easily portable wind- or waterproof outer layer when needed. Especially if wind, rain, or snow is in the forecast, this layer is essential for keeping you dry and warm.

Even when the temperatures drop, that doesn't mean you necessarily have to retreat inside your RV. The key is to design an outdoor living space that's inviting, protects you from the elements, and provides enough warmth to make crisp, cool nights enjoyable.

That starts with location. Position any outdoor furniture so it's protected under an awning or a pop-up canopy. This can be used to block wind and shelter you from light rain or snow if the weather changes. If the wind is gusty, consider adding additional windbreaks or screens. You may also want to roll out an outdoor rug, which can insulate the ground under you and make the area warmer and more inviting.

You can then add additional heat with a portable firepit or outdoor heater to gather around. Portable propane firepits are becoming popular with RVers as they're easy to transport and you don't have to find firewood. In addition, they can instantly provide warmth. Plus, even if there are fire restrictions, many campsites allow them. However, it's crucial to follow the safety guidelines and keep the firepit

a safe distance from your RV, any flammable objects, and yourself.

Another convenient option is an electric or propane portable heater. These heaters can provide targeted warmth, and many are compact enough to store in your RV when not in use. Remember, however, that these heaters are made only for outdoor use. Proper ventilation is a must to avoid any safety hazards.

Now that you're dressed well and have a heat source to stay warm, it's time to focus on ambiance. Outdoor-safe blankets and throw pillows in your seating area can exponentially increase the coziness factor. Wool and fleece are ideal because they're soft, warm, and durable enough to withstand outdoor conditions.

Finally, add some string lights or lanterns to create a soft, radiant glow around the space so it feels warmer. The added light also helps

you extend your time outside even as the sun sets earlier and earlier.



EXTEND YOUR EVENINGS AND EMBRACE THE



It doesn't take a lot of time or effort to transform your outdoor living space to extend your hours outside as the weather cools. A few slight tweaks can help you create a cozy environment well into fall and early winter. A few layers of clothing, a warming firepit or portable heater, some soft blankets, and glowing lights will help you create an inviting outdoor area so you

can enjoy those peaceful, crisp nights without feeling chilled. All that's left is to pour your favorite warming beverage—whether it's hot cocoa, spiced cider, or herbal tea—and perhaps bring out some comforting snacks.

With these simple tricks, you can savor the beauty of the cooler seasons and extend your RV adventures long after the summer sun has faded. ❤️



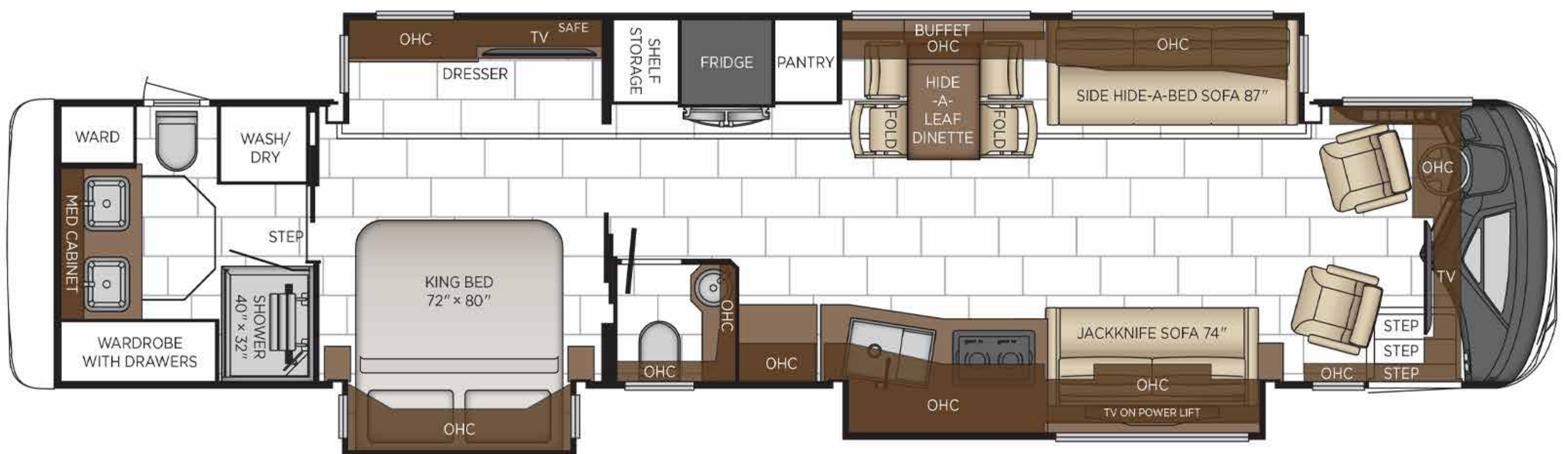

From Thor's Well, continue south on US-101 for approximately 140 miles to reach Gold Beach. The scenic drive takes about 3 hours.

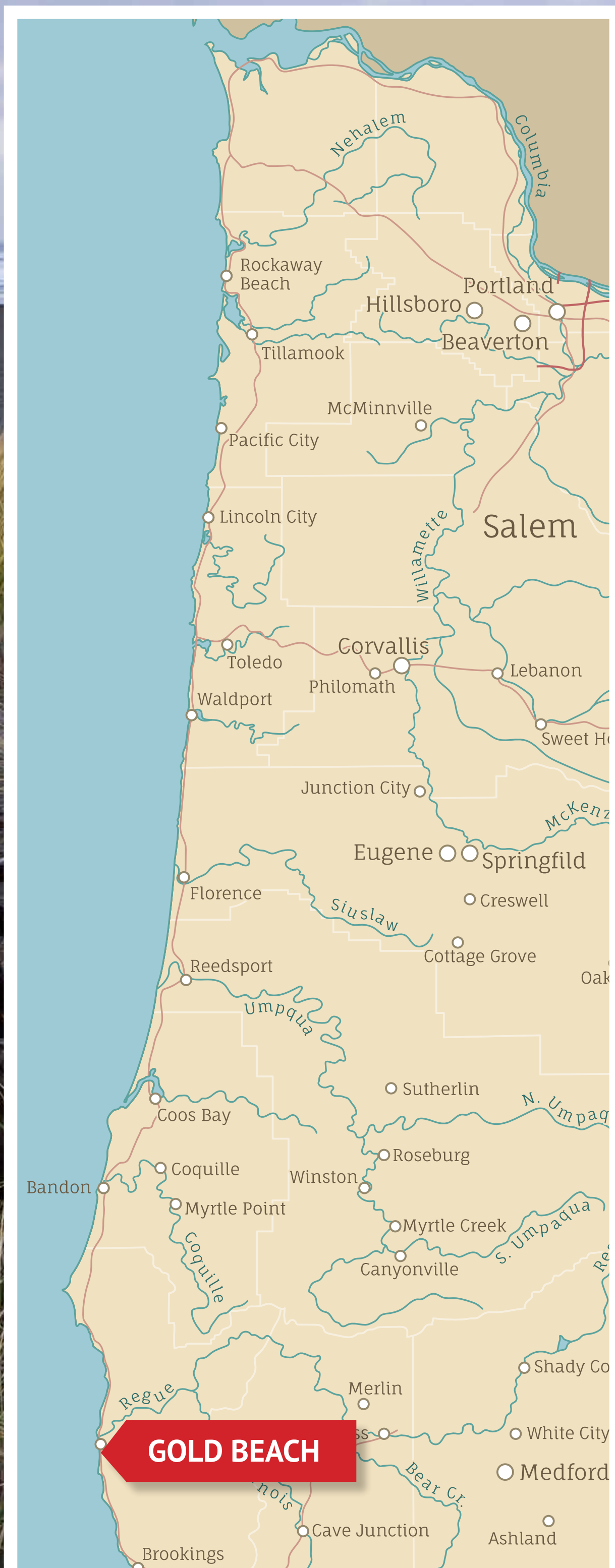
